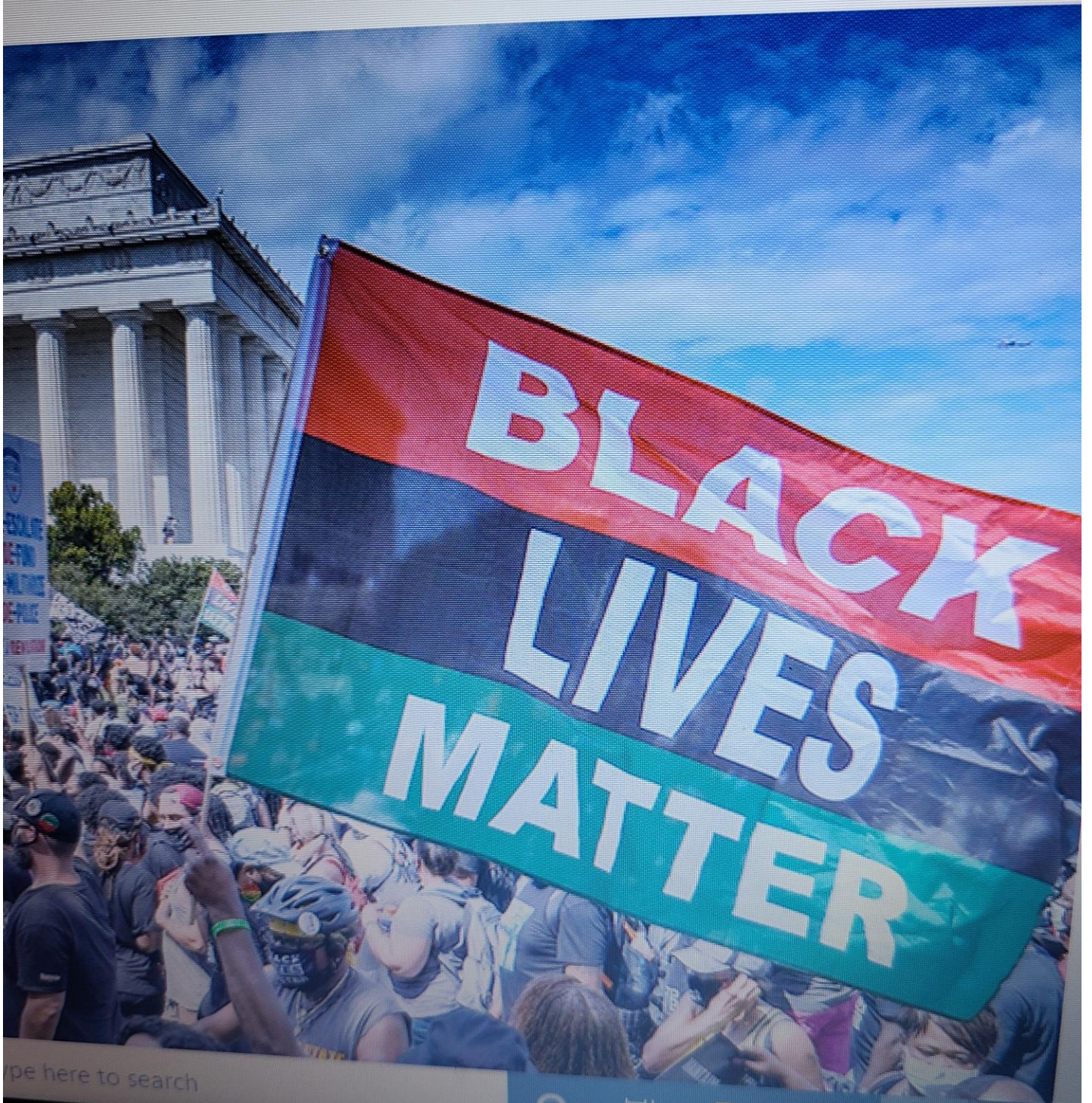
2020 March on Washington

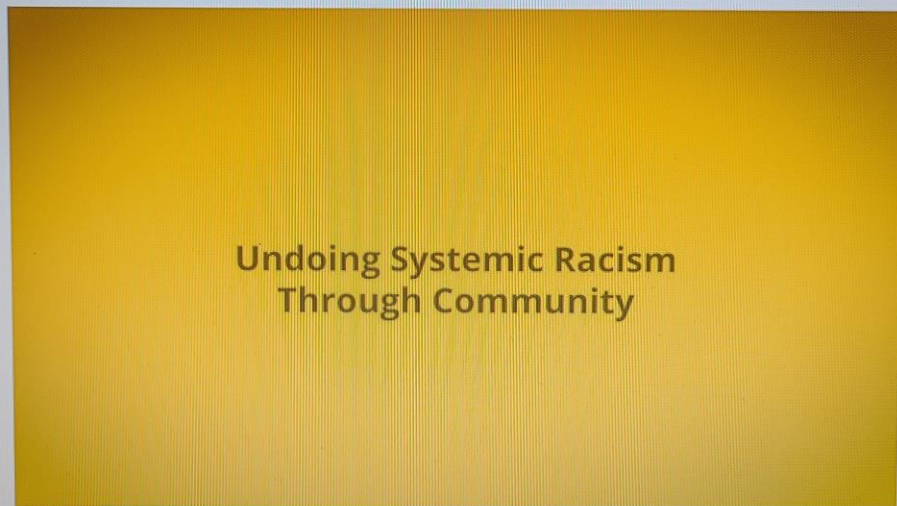

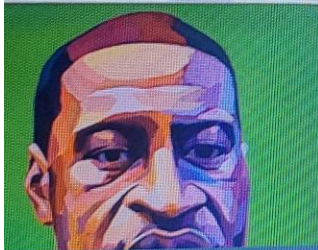

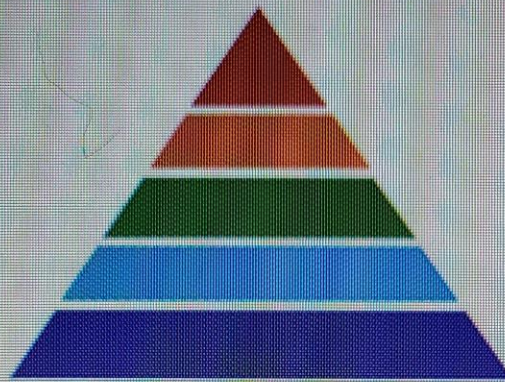
Resurgence
